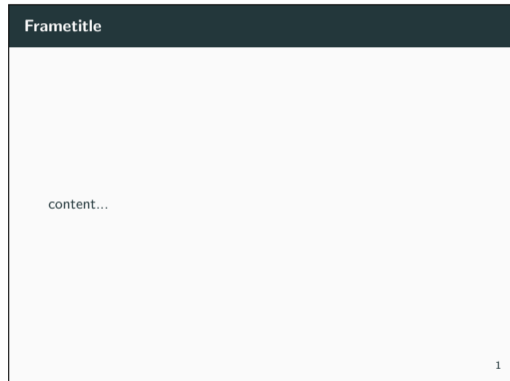

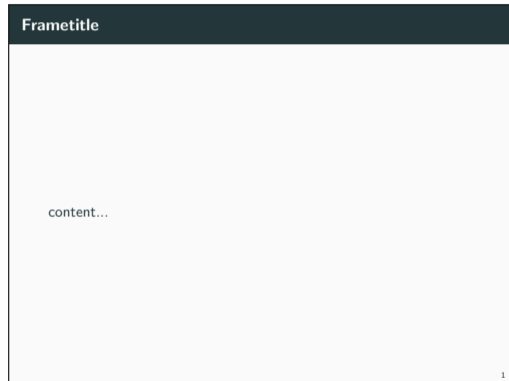

Switching to Moloch Theme

- replace `\metroset{...}` \Rightarrow `\molochset{...}`
- pgfplots: `\usepackage{pgfplots,pgfplotssthemetol}`
- fira fonts (Xe_{La}TeX + Lua_{La}TeX):
`\usepackage{fontspec}`
`\setsansfont[`
 `BoldFont={Fira Sans}, BoldItalicFont={Fira Sans Italic},`
 `ItalicFont={Fira Sans Light Italic},`
`]{Fira Sans Light}`
- math fonts (Xe_{La}TeX + Lua_{La}TeX):
`\usepackage{unicode-math}`
`\setmathfont{Fira Math Light}`
